BENEFIT/OUTCOME SUMMARY BY PROGRAM

Program 1: Pathfinder meetings and workshops

Narrative:

- Describe how the program will be carried out. Include personnel, materials, program activities and travel.

Those in attendance for the advisory board meetings are typically the public, member librarians and a representative from the library board of trustees with an average attendance of 30. Agendas are sent to all the public libraries and their board representative. Pathfinder business is conducted under the direction of the adopted bylaws and an elected trustee as chairperson. Member libraries offer to host the meeting and in this manner the meetings rotate among the libraries within the federation. Library directors and board members are encouraged to car pool. Travel expense is reimbursed for one car to attend meetings at the current state rate of 44.5 cents per mile. The permanent host library (Choteau County Library-Fort Benton) is reimbursed \$300.00 for serving a lunch. These meetings create positive energy for networking among member libraries.

Ideally, there would be a training or CE opportunity at each of these meetings.

Benefit/Outcome:

Our bi-annual meetings are a great chance to interact with our fellow Federation libraries; to gain from their knowledge, education and experiences.

The training is helpful and the opportunity for face to face time with our State Librarian and the MSL staff is invaluable. Any and all questions and concerns can be readily addressed at that time.

Taking the time away is always a struggle in a small library, but I always feel it is worth it in the end.

Continuing education will improve information delivery and library service to all Montana citizens. Strong continuing education opportunities will give all Montana libraries the common goals of MSL. It will encourage small rural library staff members to reach out, learn, change and plan. Librarians will be reminded to view the Montana Library Event calendar for upcoming training/CE opportunities. MSL staff will contact librarians in the federation alerting them to events and librarians are encouraged to watch wired-mt for postings about trainings. MSL will also advise them of potential new technologies for their libraries.

Benefit/Outcome:

The following will be the often heard lyrics, to the tiny budget tune, that all small libraries sing; but a one and a two...

Without these monies, that allow small libraries to attend MLA, the Fall Workshop, other training and professional resources, it would never happen at all.

Monies pay for tech support, to allow access to the online resources available through MSL, various colleges and internet programs.

Training and education are critical for the professional growth and well being of our rural librarians. They are often under considerable pressure, to provide greater and more advanced resources, with facilities, monetary support and technology better suited to 1980.

This can lead to hopelessness, burn out and eventually poorer service for the patron.

Just the boost from knowing that you are not alone, is often worth the time and money, to rub shoulders with your fellow librarians, the MSL staff, and board members.

The money in this program, and I'm not being dramatic, is "vital" to our growth as librarians and for our library to remain a valuable, ever growing resource for our community.
