

BARD user pledge

Participants must agree to our pledge:

National Library Service for the Blind and Physically Handicapped Download Agreement

I understand and agree to the following:

The braille and recorded materials provided by the National Library Service for the Blind and Physically Handicapped, Library of Congress are reproduced and distributed in specialized formats exclusively for use by blind, visually impaired, or physically handicapped individuals under the authority of Section 121 of Title 17 the United States Code, or with permission of the copyright owner(s). Use of NLS-produced materials is limited to eligible residents of the United States and US citizens living abroad.

NLS patrons may download materials from BARD solely for their personal use. Downloaded books and magazines may not be reproduced, transmitted, displayed, distributed, sold, or transferred under any circumstances.

User IDs and passwords may not be shared with anyone, except by NLS patrons who rely on trusted personal assistants to access BARD, in which case those users are responsible for ensuring their assistants' compliance with this pledge. The Library of Congress actively monitors the NLS system to protect against unauthorized use, and maintains records of persons downloading materials from this web site.

NLS patrons who violate this pledge will have their privileges under the NLS program suspended or revoked; will be required to surrender federal property in their possession; and may be subject to other penalties, including criminal penalties, under federal law.
