

HONORING THE CARNEGIE LEGACY IN MONTANA

The Project

- ❖ Between 1893 and 1919, Andrew Carnegie granted funds to construct nearly 1,700 free public libraries across the United States. City officials, women's clubs and businesses joined together in seventeen Montana communities to meet the requirements and successfully build those libraries. Fifteen Carnegie Library buildings survive in Montana today. Nine are still public libraries
- ❖ One-hundred years after the last Carnegie Library was built in Montana, the History Foundation is collaborating with librarians and other community members to preserve and interpret Andrew Carnegie's important legacy.

The Challenge

- ❖ The History Foundation is seeking your help to preserve, restore, and recognize the fifteen significant Carnegie Library buildings that stand today.
- Original architectural components and materials are expensive to reproduce and repair; effective operation and maintenance of these century-old buildings is daunting; physical obstacles like lath and plaster walls can hinder interior upgrades and retrofitting.
