**Re:** Library Strategies Introduction

On March 16 the Montana State Library and Library Strategies entered into an eighteenmonth contract under which Library Strategies will lead the effort to form a nonprofit which will raise private funds for the Montana libraries and information community.

Library Strategies is uniquely qualified to do this work. They are a consulting group of The Friends of the Saint Paul Public Library in Minnesota. They have worked in 30 states, including Montana, to conduct strategic planning and to develop friends and foundations. Executive Director (ED) Stu Wilson has more than 25 years of fundraising experience and is the former ED of the Friends of the Hennepin County Library. Karen Rose has more than 15 years of fundraising experience.
