Re: State Publications Management Plan and Administrative Rules

Following a month-long public comment period, staff asks the Commission to adopt the plan as presented. Changes noted reflect staff recommendations based on the comments we received. As was noted during the April Commission meeting, 22-1-212, Montana Code Annotated requires the State Library to adopt rules to carry out the provisions of the State Publications Depository Library Program. Staff intends to adopt this plan into administrative rule later this year following the timeline noted below.

2018 Timeline:

June 13 Draft State Publications Management Plan presented to the State Library Commission for initial review and comment;

June 14 Draft State Publications Management Plan released for public comment;

August 1 Public comment period ends;

August 8 Public comments, agency responses and a revised State Publication Management Plan shared with the Commission;

Commission may take action to adopt the plan or the Commission may delay action until their October meeting;

Following approval of the plan staff will initiate an administrative rules process including a public comment period and public hearing if necessary;

December 12 Commission adopts final State Publications Depository Library Program Administrative Rules.
