Re: Finalized Priority of MLIA GRANT FY2023

The attached report outlines the finalized priority order of grants for the Montana Land Information Act Grant Program State Fiscal Year 2023, based on ARM 10.102.9105.

A total of eight grant applications were submitted to the Montana State Library for consideration for the FY23 MLIA Grant Program. The Grant Review Subcommittee reviewed and ranked all applications.

The eight grants currently total \$283,973. The Subcommittee and I determined that some individual applications need to have tasks and associated budget items removed due to duplication of services that will be offered through the State Library or because task(s) does not align with grant criteria. For example, the 1Spatial Data validation tool used to validate 9-1-1 data resources.

The Subcommittee and MSL staff have identified four grants whose scope of work and budgets need to be modified. Upon completion, total grant funds to be awarded will be equal to or less than the budgeted amount of \$250,000.

MSL staff has determined that some of the lower ranked grants do not qualify for full funding, due to data resources, services, or workflows at the State Library or other State Agencies that already accomplish one or more of their stated goals, objectives, tasks. However, in the interest of serving the Montana GIS Community, we will fund some of the approved goals, objectives, tasks that currently exist within the applications.
