I am pleased to inform you all that we conducted a successful election this year and had a good voting turnout. We elected three new members to the board and the proposed bylaw changes passed by wide margin. The following members were elected to the board:

Vice President (three-year term) - Jeff Sprock, City of Billings
Member Development Chair (two-year term) - Mike Eidum, MDT
Conference Liaison (two-year term) - Haley Jurecki, Axim Geospatial

The proposed [changes](#) to MAGIP's Bylaws in Article II, Sections 1 and 4, **PASSED** with 88% of the respondents voting 'For', 10.6% voting to 'Abstain' and 1.5% voting 'Against' the changes.
