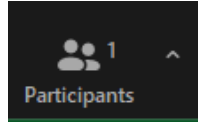


Zooming like a pro!

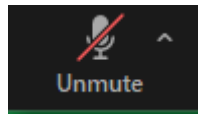
- Rename Yourself

- Open “Participants”
- Hover over your name
- Click “Rename”
 - Include your name, library, and role



- Audio

- Remain muted unless speaking to avoid background noise. Click “unmute” to speak up.
- If you do not have a microphone, you can call in on a phone.



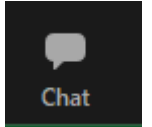
- Video

- We love seeing your smiling faces, but if you prefer to, you can turn video off by clicking “Stop Video” in the lower left-hand corner of the Zoom screen.



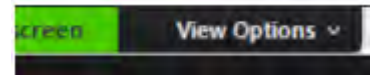
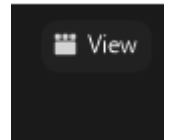
- Chat

- Click the “Chat” icon to add your comments or questions.



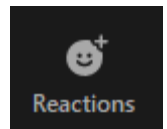
- View Options

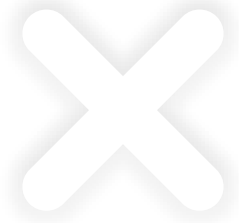
- Choose how you want to see the speaker and other participants. Choose gallery for the Brady Bunch effect.

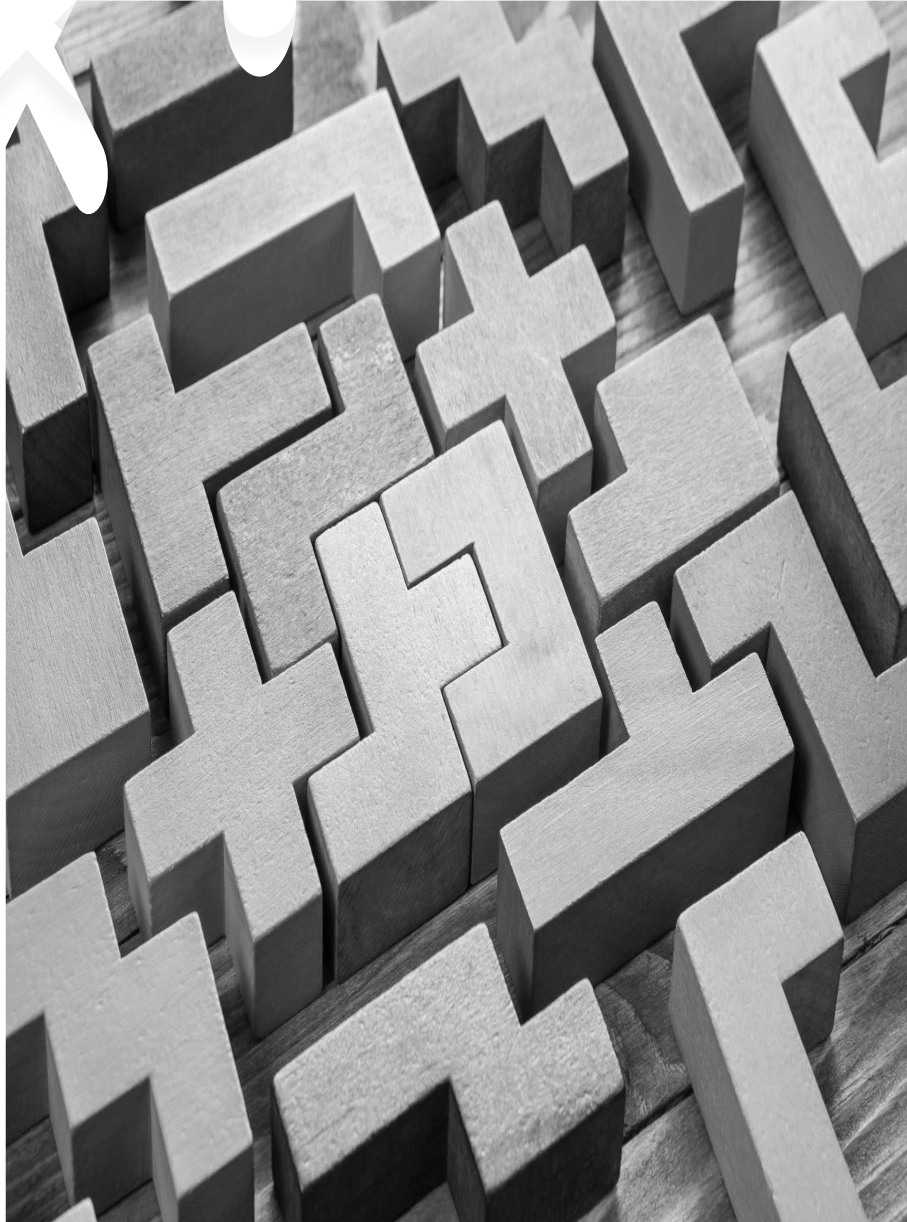

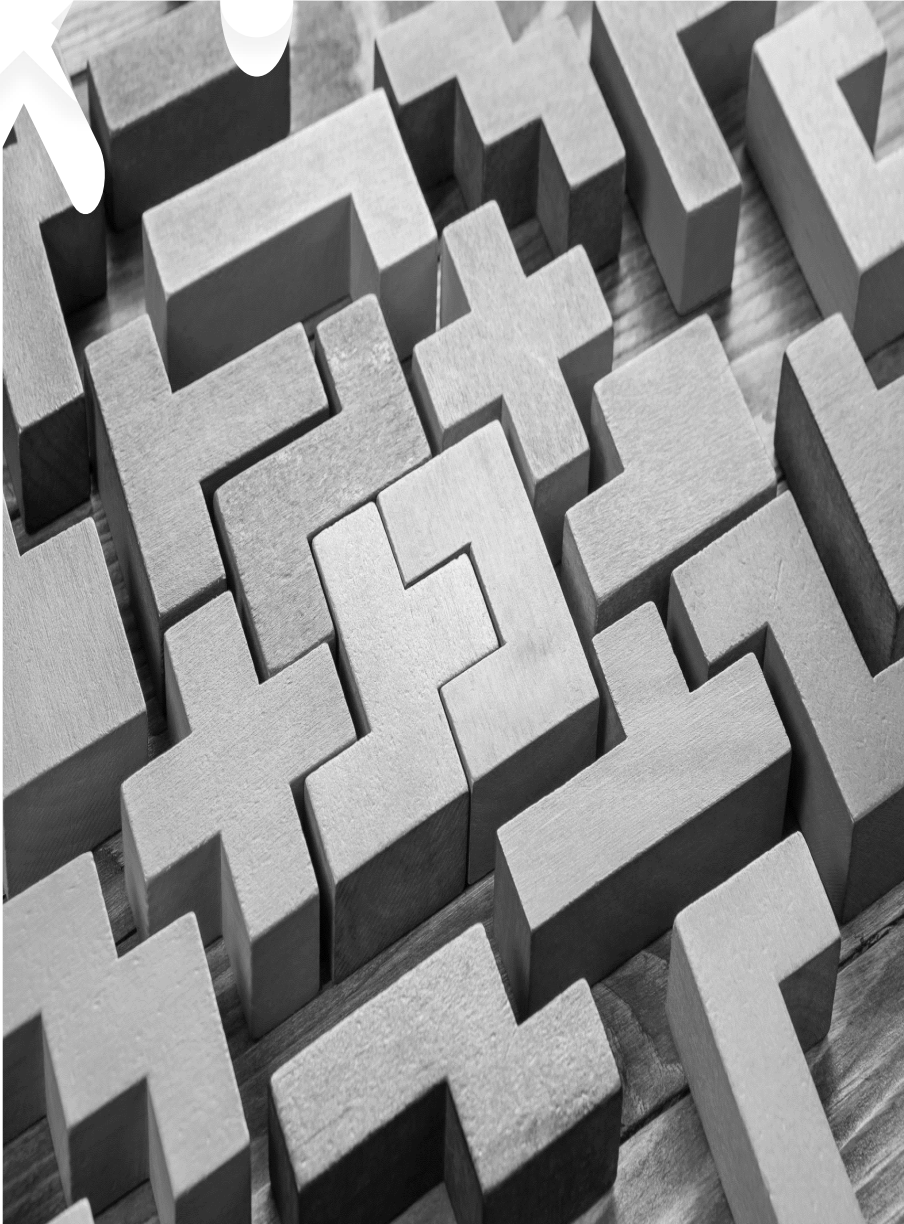

Per Capita/Per Square Mile State Aid

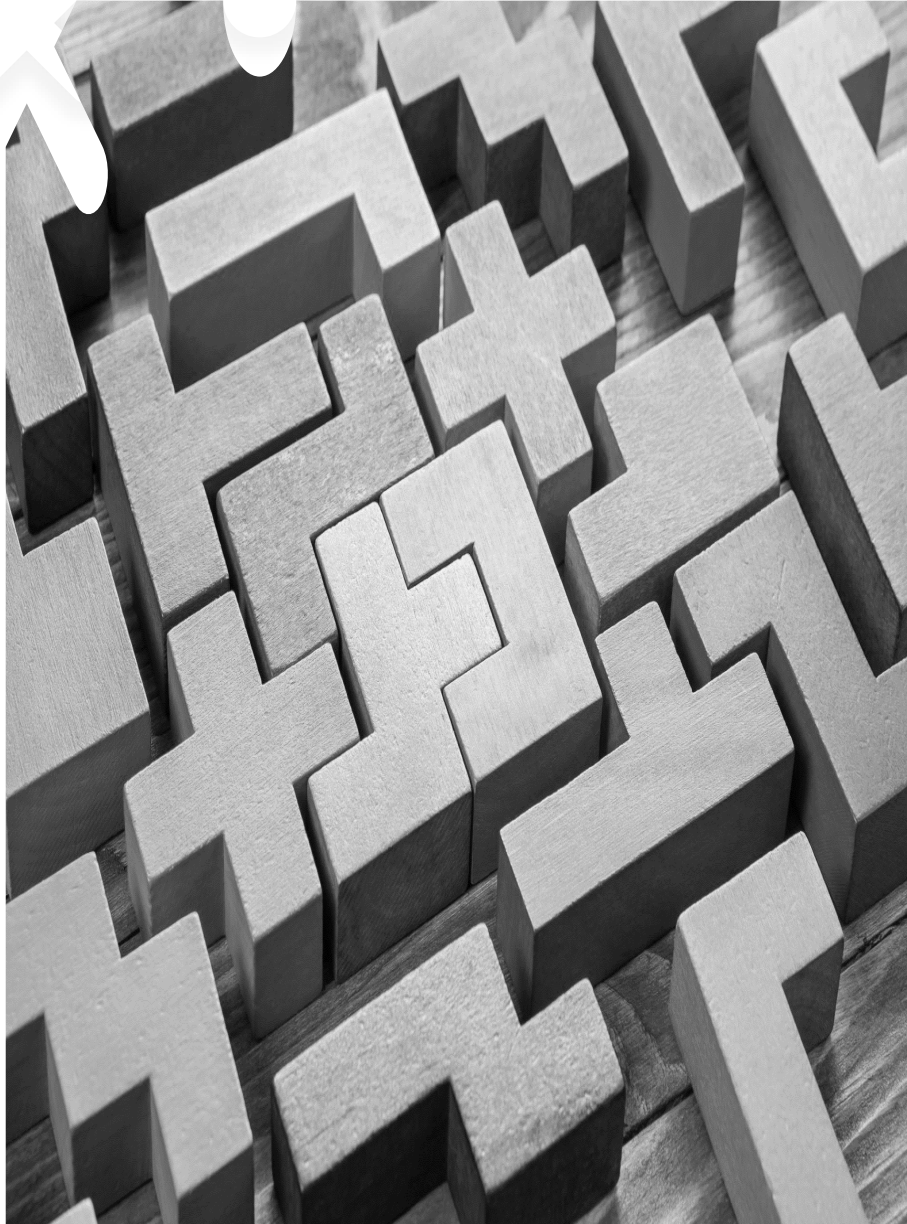
