

Recommendation Summary

Draft Task Force Recommendations

In general, the Task Force recommends

- Adopting fewer, clearer, measurable, and actionable program goals;
- Adjusting the Library Administration Track to allow simplification and flexibility;
- Maintaining the Voluntary Trustee Track Requirements as is;
- Adjusting the Voluntary Staff Track requirements to allow simplification and flexibility;
- Addressing user experience with ASPeN to eliminate barriers to tracking continuing education credits;
- Providing lists of recommended courses for each certification track;
- Developing an accessible and consistent plan to promote Continuing Education and Certification Program and,
- · Planning implementation for an effective date of July 1, 2024.
