

The superintendent of public instruction shall have power to adopt a course of studies and rules and regulations for all public schools in the territory; and shall have and use a seal, and authorize the printing of all regulations and circulars necessary to carry their provisions into effect; and shall report to the governor biennially, on or before the first day of December of the years in which the regular sessions of the legislature are held. The governor shall transmit said report to the legislature, and, whenever it is ordered printed, a sufficient number of copies shall be delivered to the superintendent of public instruction, to furnish two copies to be deposited in the territorial library, and one copy to each superintendent of common schools, to be held by him as public property, and delivered to his successor in office; and one copy to each local school officer within the territory. Said report shall contain a statement of the condition of the public schools in the territory, full statistical tables by

The undertaking for the attachment need only be executed in the sum claimed as damages.
