- Avoid litigation
- Maintain local authority over species management
- Save time and money

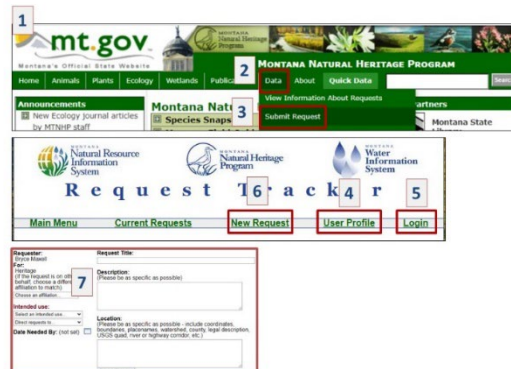
